Divide summer-blooming plants

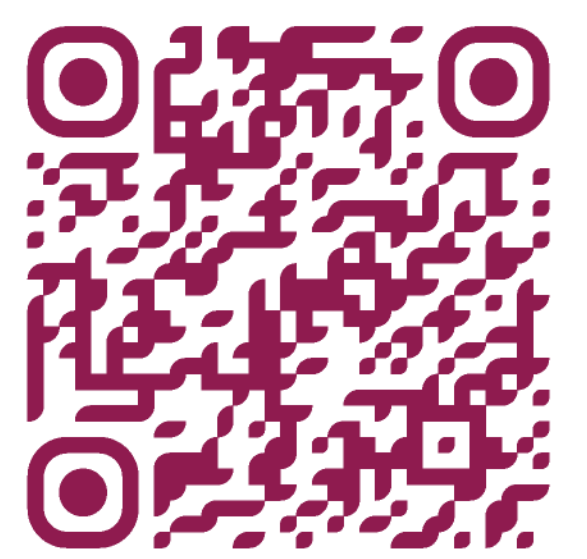

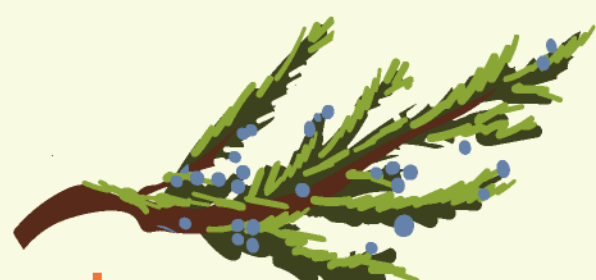


PLANT FOR WILDLIFE:
