Add seasonal plants to your indoor collection - lemon cypress, norfolk island pine, cyclamen, holiday cactus, poinsettias.

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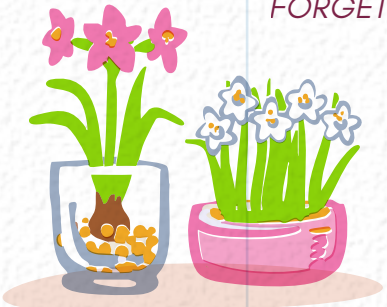
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FORGET-ME-NOT DAY

Increase humidity with pebble trays or humidifiers to combat dry indoor air.

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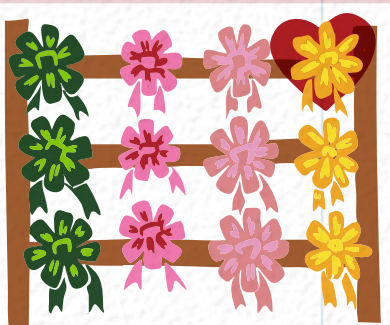
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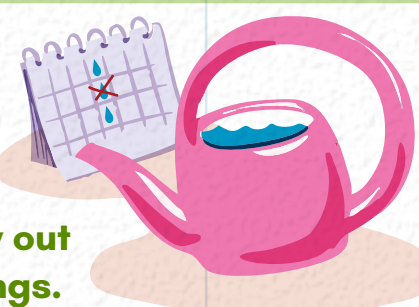


Stop by the bow wall and pick your favorite.
