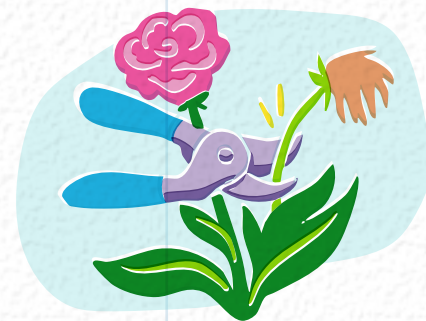

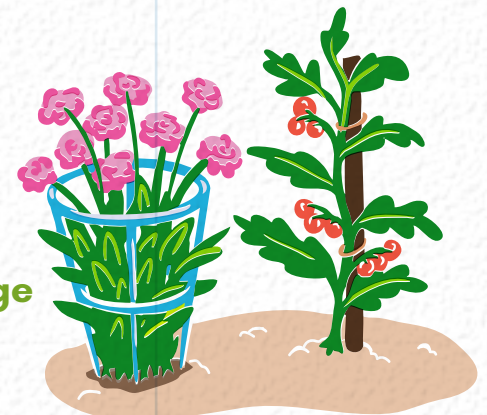
GENERAL CARE
